

Monday, October 26th, 1936

The regular semi-monthly meeting of the Lancaster Stamp Club was held on the above date at 8 P.M. in the Y.M.C.A. There were 9 members and 1 visitor in attendance.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer reported a balance on hand from the last meeting in the amount of \$ 8.50 with receipts of \$1.50; Expenditures of \$ 7.43; leaving a balance to date of \$ 2.57

There were no committee reports.

The will of Rev. Geo. Roath, one of the Lancaster Stamp Club's oldest members who recently passed away, was read. It instructed Rev. C.E. Berghaus to dispose of his stamp collection and that the Lancaster Stamp Club was to receive 20% of the proceeds. The collection was exhibited by Rev. Berghaus and it was suggested that it be disposed of at auction either the whole, or in part. It was also suggested that it be sold at an auction sometime in January. The collection consisted of Modern U.S. and Foreign.

The program for the next meeting will be an auction.

As there was no further business the meeting was adjourned.
