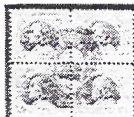

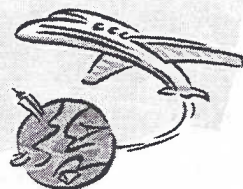

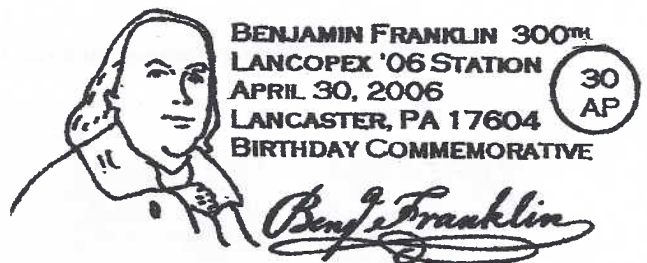

Benjamin Franklin: Born in Boston Jan. 17, 1706; formal education ended at age 10. Apprenticed as a **Printer** with his brother at age 12. Left in 1723 to begin a career in Philadelphia as a publisher and writer. At age 31 Franklin was appointed **Postmaster** of Philadelphia by the British Crown. Sold his publishing business in 1748 to devote more time to study and public service. Appointed Deputy Postmaster General by the British and after many years he was dismissed for "actions in behalf of the colonies" (His free frank "Free B. Franklin" had become "B Free Franklin") As a **Statesman** served on the Continental Congress, helped draft and sign the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution, served as an delegate to France and Great Britain. As a **Scientist**, in addition to his famous kite experiment, the lighting rod, bifocals, a heating stove are only a few of his many inventions. Franklin died in Philadelphia on April 17, 1790.

Lancopex is honored to produce a cover to commemorate his accomplishments.

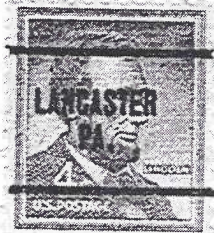

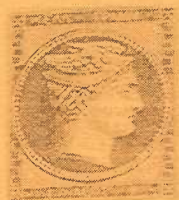
