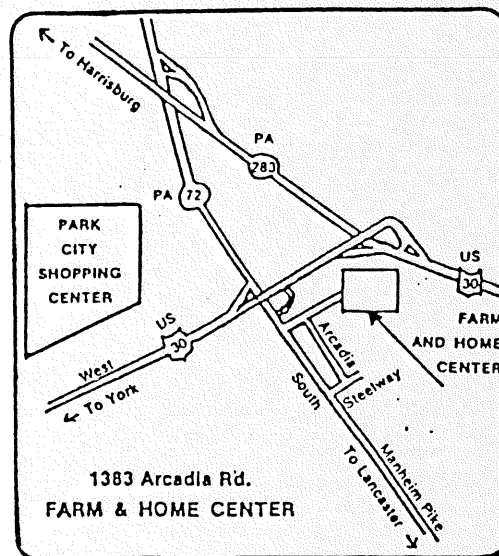
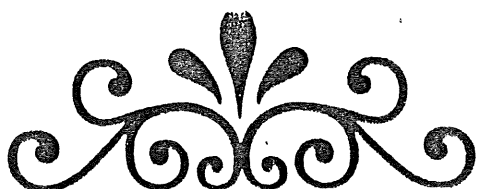
FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK!

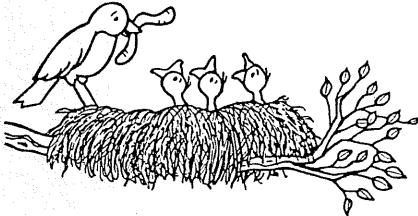

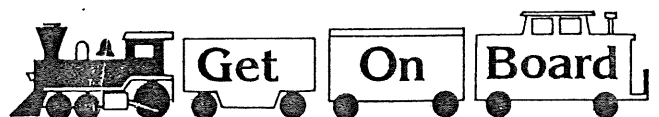
