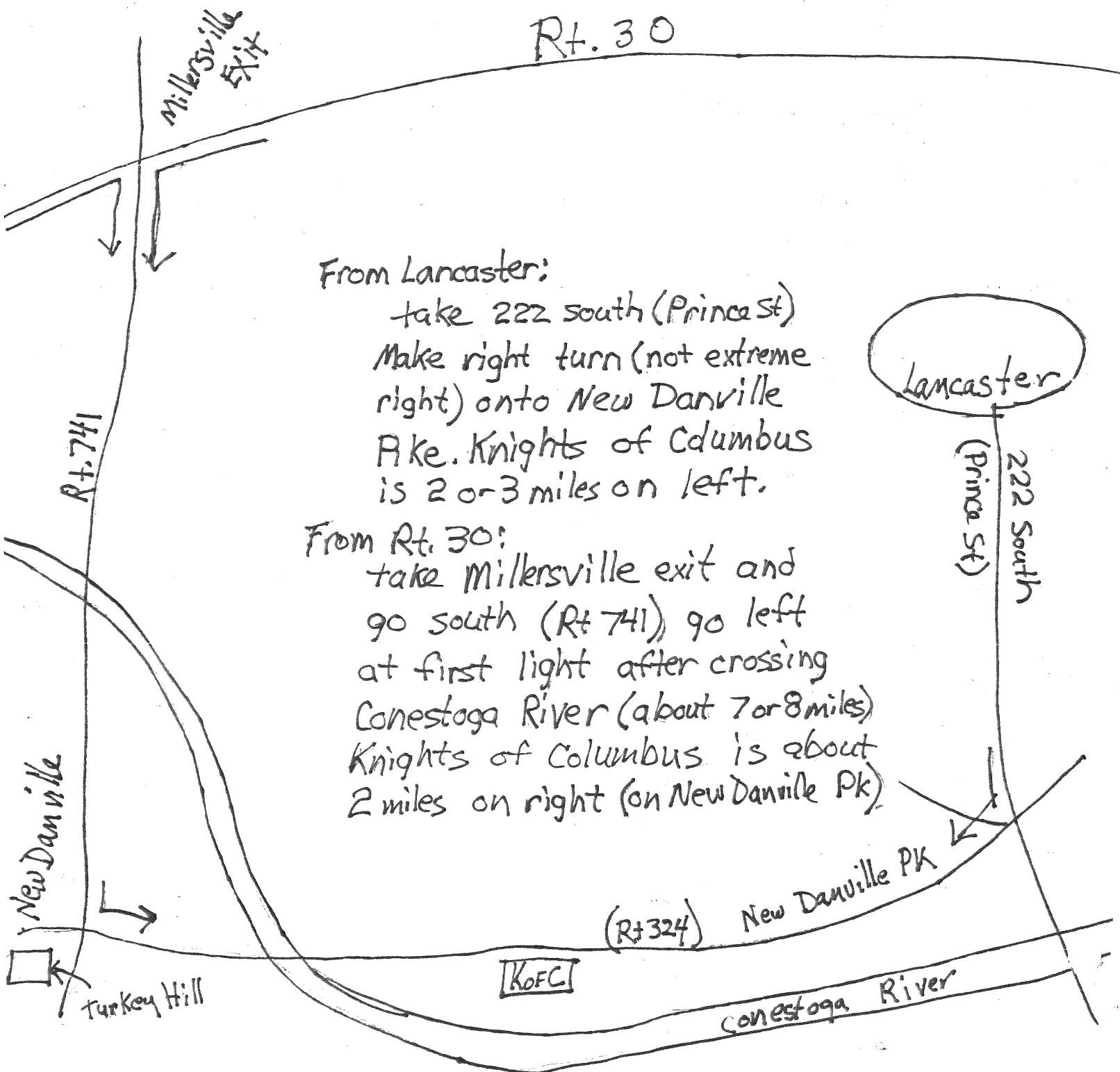

at first light after crossing
Conestoga River (about 7 or 8 miles)
Knights of Columbus is about
2 miles on right (on New Danville Pk)
