

2018 marks the 125th Anniversary of the Columbian Exposition in Chicago (1 May – 30 October 1893). In honor of the Chicago Fair, the Society's Design Team is creating a Chicago Fair-themed cachet, an 1893 Exposition Station Circular Date Stamp (CDS), and a 33rd Annual Lancopex Stamp Show 2018 hand stamp. The limited edition cover will also include a genuine Scott #230 1 Cent Columbian canceled with the CDS. 
