Guests are always welcome and membership is open to all stamp collectors regardless of expertise.

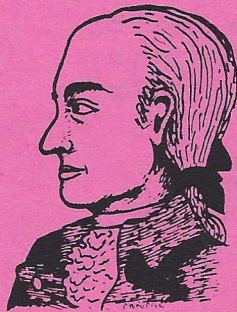

LANCOPEX '94 CACHET/CANCELLATION



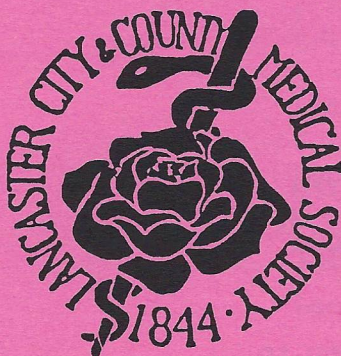
The 29 cent Rose self-adhesive definitive stamp was chosen as the stamp for the commemorative envelope of the LANCOPEX '94 Stamp Show. Club members felt this popular stamp deserved recognition by Lancaster, PA, THE Red Rose city. Voted Best Design of a 1993 definitive by the readers of Linn's Stamp News, this stamp had first day of issue ceremonies on August 19, 1993 in Houston, Texas at Stampshow, the annual exhibition of the American Philatelic Society. The cachet rose was created by Paul Ripple, MD and complements the red rose stamp.

EDWARD HAND



Born on December 31, 1744 Edward Hand came to America in 1767 as a young surgeon with an Irish regiment. He resigned his commission in the British army in 1774, started a practice of medicine in Lancaster, and married a Lancaster girl in 1775. That same year Hand was commissioned into the Continental army where he was highly regarded by George Washington and his troops. After a distinguished military career General Hand and his family returned to Lancaster in 1783. Two years later General Hand bought land overlooking the Conestoga River and construction of his home Rock Ford was begun. By 1793 he was living there. General Hand served as Chief Burgess of Lancaster, a member of the Continental Congress, a member of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives and Vestryman of St. James Church. Edward Hand's friendship with George Washington continued until Hand's death September 3, 1802.

LANCASTER CITY AND COUNTY MEDICAL SOCIETY



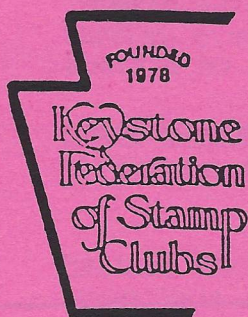
The Lancaster County Philatelic Society congratulates the Lancaster City and County Medical Society on its 150th anniversary. Lancaster physicians were prominent in the development of the state Pennsylvania Medical Society and the American Medical Association in the mid 1800's. The Society helped establish a set of high ethical and professional standards for the physicians licensed in the state of Pennsylvania. Dr. John L. Atlee, Dr. Alexander Craig, Dr. Theodore B. Appel, and Dr. Frank G. Hartman have served as president of the Pennsylvania Medical Society; Dr. John L. Atlee, Dr. John Herr Musser, and Dr. James Z. Appel have served as president of the American Medical Society. The Society urged the use of universal smallpox vaccination to combat that epidemic in Philadelphia and Baltimore in 1845. In 1962 the Society conducted a massive polio immunization. In 1992 the need for health care reform was recognized with the start of the Lancaster Community Health Plan. We thank the Lancaster City and County Medical Society members for 150 years of dedicated service to our community.

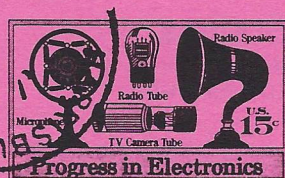

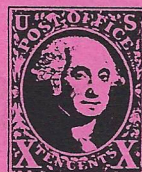
