LOCATION

Our club meets at the Farm and Home Center near Routes 30 and 72 on Arcadia Road, Lancaster, PA. From Route 72 (the Manheim Pike), enter between Conestoga Marine and Jones Honda. The club meets the third Monday of each month with the exception of the June summer picnic and the December holiday party. These events and locations are announced a few months before the occasions.

MONTHLY MEETINGS

At the monthly meetings, members set up to buy, sell and trade at 5:30 p.m. The business meeting begins at 7 p.m. followed by the monthly exhibit competition and the program. Programs might be slide or opaque projection presentations by a member, multiple-member participation, auctions, and so on until about 9 p.m. We generally have 65 to 75 members present.

LIBRARY

Books may be checked out from the library and returned on a 30-day basis at the meetings. It's best to phone our librarian to be sure the book is available since the library is not housed at the Farm and Home Center.

NATIONAL POSTCARD WEEK POSTCARD

LCPC issues its own postcard each year for exchange during National Postcard Week (NPW), the first full week of May. Remaining back issues are often available at the Club Table, along with any other postcards LCPC has issued.

MONTHLY BULLETIA

Each month, The Card, an abundantly illustrated bulletin, is published by LCPC, concentrating on postcards with an equal emphasis on education and entertainment and, of course, recent events involving our club. Many members belong to LCPC to receive The Card, even though they cannot participate actively in the meetings.

LCPC EXPO

Since 1993. the third Saturday of August has been our annual Expo day at the Farm and Home Center, hosting approximately 25 dealers selling postcards, plus a fine group of members' postcards exhibited for competition. In other words, unlike many postcard shows, ours is an "exposition" where postcards are exhibited by members as well as sold by dealers. In 1993, we named our first show "Expo" to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Columbian Exposition and the 60th anniversary of the Chicago Exposition. In addition to the exhibitions and dealers, good food made by club members is available.

PUBLICATION OF POSTCARD BOOK

In 1998, LCPC became the first (as far as we can determine) postcard club to publish a deluxe hardcover volume of local views. The culmination of more than a year's intensive work, our book *Windows to Our Past* contains 500 local postcards with captions. Forty-six members contributed views. Only 2,000 books were printed.

MEMBERSHIP AND DUES INFORMATION

Our membership year begins April 1 and concludes March 31. Dues for April 2001 until March 2002 are \$8 per member plus \$2 for each additional member at the same address with one issue of *The Card* going to each address as well as one copy of the membership roster.
