

Upper right – Luck and Joy in the New Year is the likely message contained in the letter the little lady's receiving at her tree house front steps; mailed from Hamburg, Dec. 24, 1915. Lower left – Jenny Nyström's tomten barber shaves a big porker so he's better prepared for the New Year feast (where he'll likely be the main course). Looking on are a pair of pipe puffing friends, four youngsters and another big porker sadly waiting for his close shave; mailed from New Bedford, Ma, Dec. 27, 1905. Lower right – A Good New Year (in German) is our last greeting postcard and is loaded with good luck symbols – a handful of 4-leaf clovers, a horseshoe and an over-sized animated mushroom; used but w/o a date.
