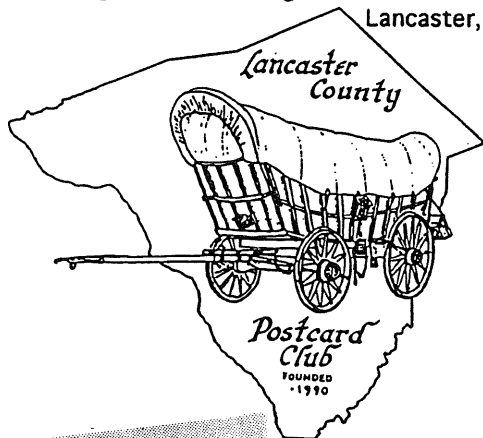

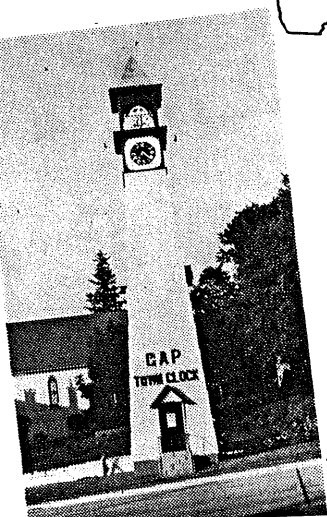

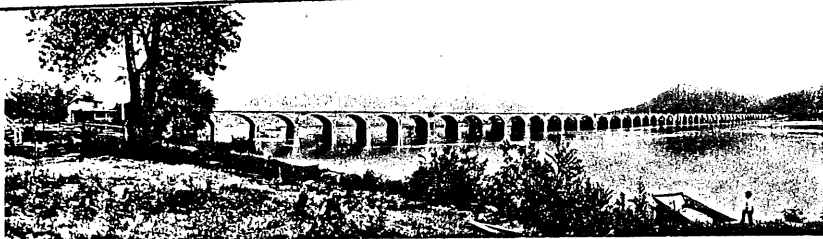

On January 22, 1990, 21 men and women met for the purpose of sharing their love of postcards* - those bits and pieces of yesterday. Today we are 273 active members of The Lancaster County Postcard Club.

Our monthly meetings are open to the public. You may join us in sharing what we learn about postcards through our extensive library, educational programs and exhibits. We have postcard competition and auctions on a regular basis, a summer picnic meeting and Christmas dinner meeting.

Each year LCPC issues a unique PC* honoring National Postcard Week - the first full week in May. Each month members receive an 8-page illustrated bulletin, THE CARD** which keeps them informed if they can't attend meetings and offers

local postcard history and general knowledge about our hobby.

A 32-page illustrated history was published at the end of the club's first five years. A few are available.

LCPC's latest project is a book of Lancaster City and County postcards. It will contain 500 local views with narrative and scarcity rating for each card. It will be available at our 1998 Expo. 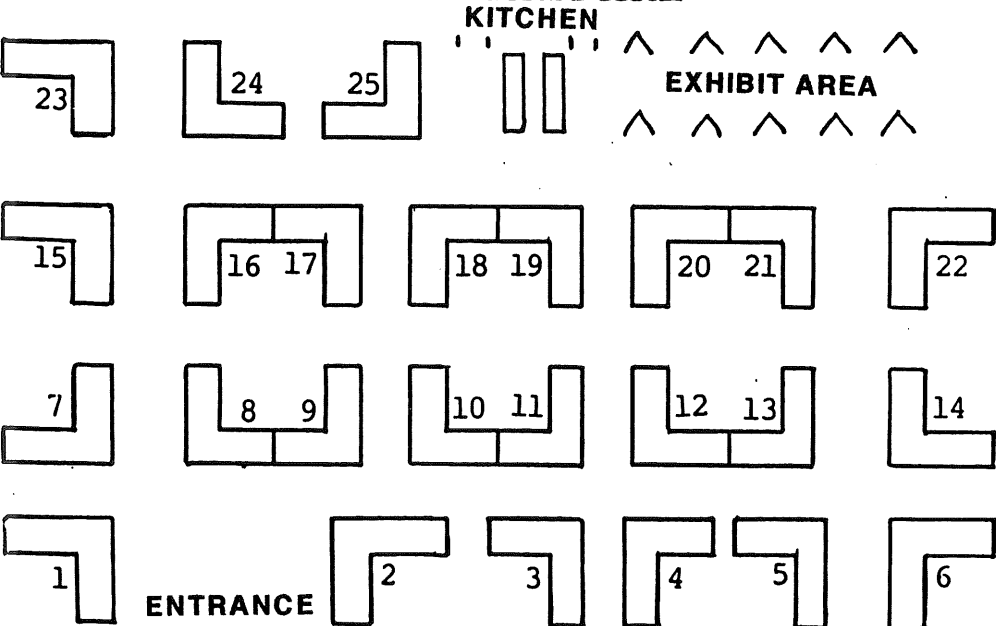

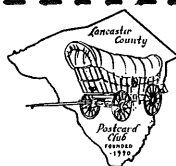
