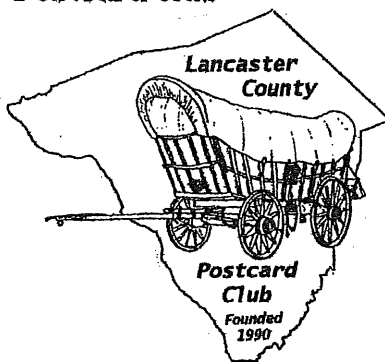

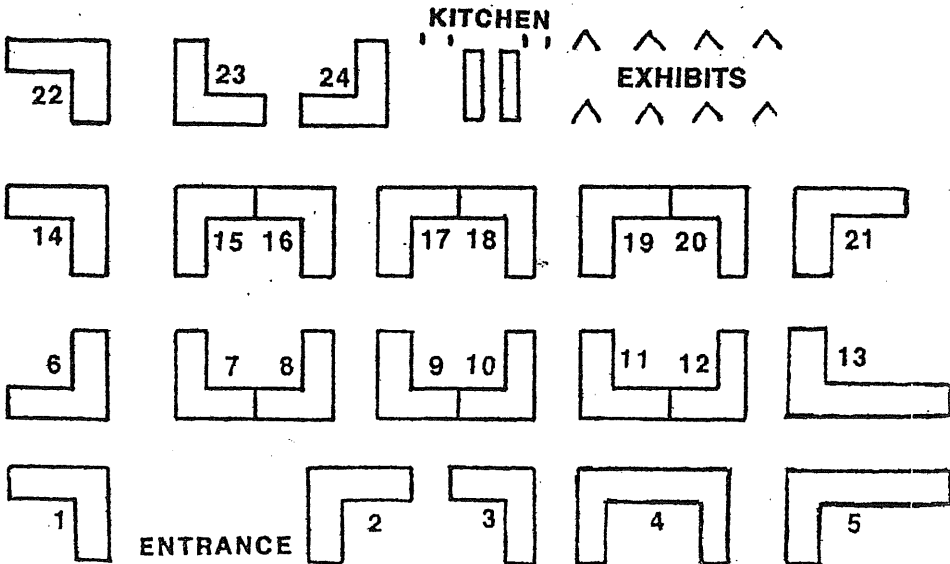

Where You'll Find Them



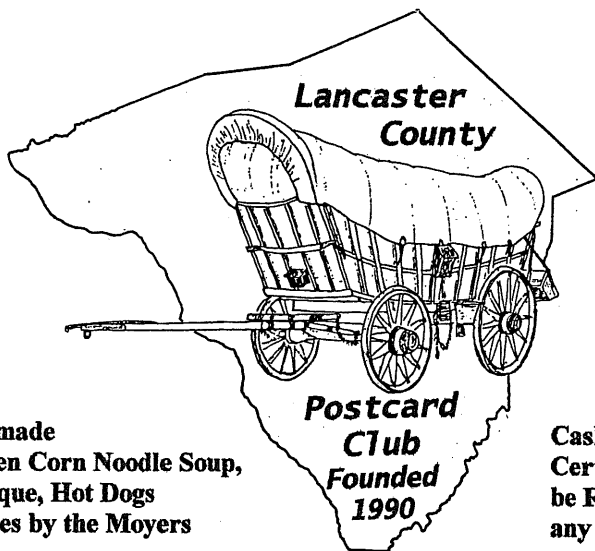
You're Invited to become a member of LCPC – the Lancaster County Postcard Club.

We have competitive postcard exhibits at nearly every meeting. Highlights of the year include publishing a National Postcard Week card in spring, a picnic and our Expo in the summer, a postcard auction in the fall and an annual Christmas party.

Our monthly publication, *The Card*, includes club news, local postcard history and general articles covering many different topics.

In 1998 our club published a hard cover deluxe edition book of 500 local postcard views with descriptions and values. Windows to Our Past, we've learned, is the first book of its size and substance to be published by a postcard club. The edition of 2000 is sold out. 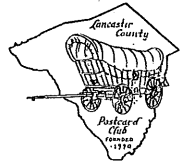
