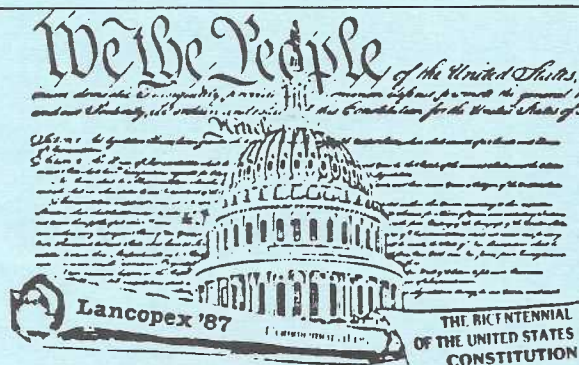

Finally after many disagreements and revisions, the New Constitution was adopted which began with the famous words "We the People of the United States"

Our background cachet features a copy of the Constitution behind the present Capitol dome. LCPS will reprint the cachet as a FDC for the "Signing of the Constitution stamp to be issued September 17, 1987.
