
Why Select this Topic for Research?

- What follows is the story of Banking in the Village and Town of Pawling from 1849 to 1929 through these paper artifacts.










History of Banks in Pawling

- * The Bank of Pawling was organized in 1849, under the old State laws.
 - Officers were Albert J. Akin, President; J.W. Bowdish, Cashier.
 - Bank changed to National Bank of Pawling (NBP), in June, 1865.
 - Officers remained the same. Cashier in 1882 was George W. Chase.
 - Inactive as NBP Jan. 29th 1983; Acquired by First Niagara Bank Oct 8th, 2016.
- * The Pawling Savings Bank was chartered & incorporated in 1870, and was opened for deposits in 1871.
 - First President David R. Gould, figured prominently in its organization, and died in February, 1873.
 - William J. Merwin, first Treasurer & Jedediah Wanzer, first Secretary.
 - Bank deposits in July 1880 were \$82,000. In 1881, had surplus of \$5,000.
 - Officers 1882: John J. Vanderburgh, President; W. H. Taber, Vice-President; Jedediah I.
 Wanzer, Secretary; William J. Merwin, Treasurer; Horace D. Dufcut, Attorney.
 - Institution closed June 9th, 2006.



Bank of Pawling – Fractional Currency













These notes were a written promise to pay the stated sum to Bank of Pawling. As can be seen both were paid,; note written manuscript "PAID". Additionally, the May 1866 note has a red "NATIONAL" handstamp, denoting name change that occurred in June 1865.






