

Monday, February 24th, 1936

The regular semi-monthly meeting of the Lancaster Stamp Club was held on the above date in the Y.M.C.A. at 8 P.M. There were twenty-one members and two visitors in attendance. The president, Thomas A. Keller, was in charge.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the secretary and approved with one correction.

The treasurer reported a balance on hand as of Feb. 10th, in the amount of \$ 4.53. The receipts \$ 8.60 and expenditures of \$ 3.38, leaving a balance to date of \$ 9.75.

Mr. Edw. Evans gave a short report on the work of the Publicity Committee. Mr. Mentzer, chairman of the Program Committee, stated that he would like to have the Club's reaction as to the types of programs desired at the meetings.

A motion was made by Mr. Mentzer that the secretary be instructed to follow up the correspondence in reference to the Nat'l. Federation of Stamp Club's, believing it to be of benefit to the local organization. The motion passed. Dr. Arthur Gerhart was elected local representative of the Federation and Clarence W. Brazer, regional representative. It was moved and formally passed that the dues (\$1.00) of the Federation for the current year be paid.

Mr. Carl Zeigler, 724 Sixth St., and John J. Kiphorn, Millersville, R. #1., were elected to membership.

A bill for .30cts for postage was presented by the secretary and ordered paid.

A prospectus for the Third Annual Exhibition of the Pottstown Y.M.C.A. Stamp Club, March 19-22nd, was read and ordered filed. A letter was received from Richard Minnich of the Yorktowne Philatelic Society inviting the club to attend a joint meeting with the York Club at Mr. Minnich's home on March 10th. No action was taken on this matter.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
