

1971 British Postal Strike

- ❖ BRITAIN'S FIRST NATIONAL POSTAL STRIKE
- ❖ BEGAN AFTER POSTAL WORKERS DEMANDED A PAY RISE OF 15–20%
- ❖ THE STRIKE BEGAN ON 20 JANUARY & LASTED FOR SEVEN WEEKS
- ❖ ENDED WITH AN AGREEMENT ON THURSDAY 4 MARCH
- ❖ STRIKERS RETURNED TO WORK ON MONDAY 8 MARCH 1971
- ❖ **DECIMAL DAY** OCCURRED ON 15 FEBRUARY 1971, THE DAY ON WHICH THE UK & IRELAND DECIMALISED ITS CURRENCY
- ❖ WIDE RANGE OF OFFICIALLY LICENSED AND UNLICENSED PRIVATE POSTS OPERATED DURING THE STRIKE
- ❖ SOME WERE GENUINE COMMERCIAL SERVICES THAT PROVIDED LOCAL, NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL DELIVERIES, BUT MANY WERE SET UP BY STAMP COLLECTORS AND STAMP DEALERS
