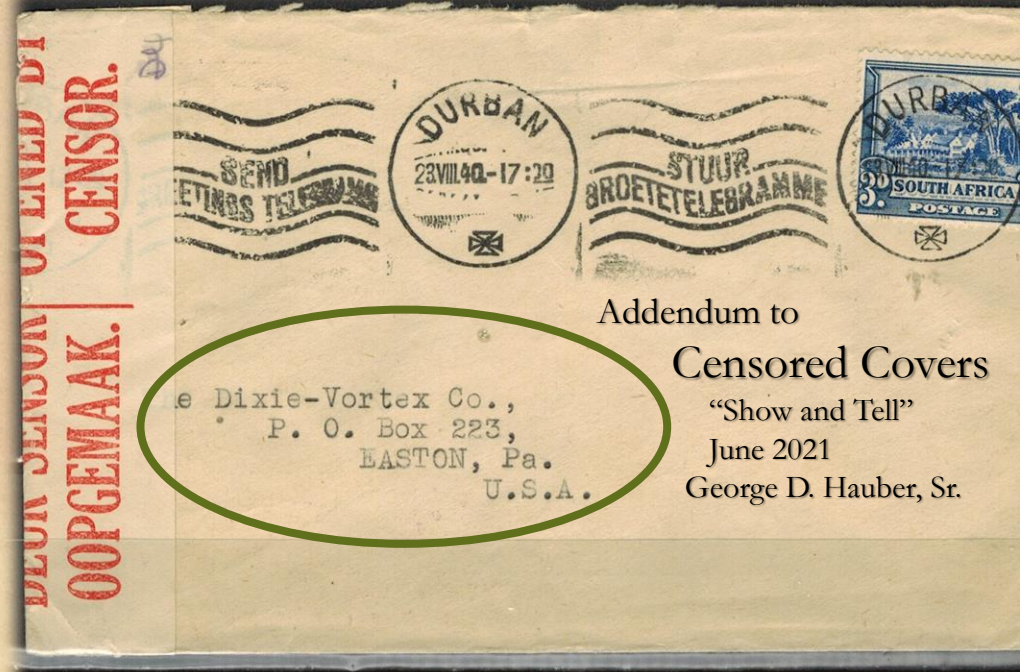
# The Dixie Cup Plant Easton, PA



The Lehigh Valley manufacturing plant that has produced iconic Dixie Cups for nearly a century will shut down operations the end of 2021, owner Georgia-Pacific announced.

*"Lehigh Valley will continue to make cups to support the business for the next several months as some of its cup-making equipment is relocated to the Lexington site..."*

*"...With the closure of the Lehigh Valley plant, it means that after 2021 all Dixie cups, including premium hot cups, recycled fiber cups and bath cups, will be made at the Lexington plant."*
