Priced higher than regular postage, they pay the current mailing rate, with an added amount contributed to a charitable cause

Semi-postal Stamps

The world's first semi-postal stamps were issued in **1897** by **New South Wales**, a British colony (now a part of Australia)

A surcharge over the regular postal rate was added to stamps commemorating *Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee*




Semi-postal Stamps

The revenue generated by this additional fee was used to build the *Queen Victoria Home for Consumptives*




The design of the 1-penny + 1-shilling (B1) stamp depicts a winged angel ministering to a patient.

The revenue generated by this additional fee was used to build the *Queen Victoria Home for Consumptives* (for victims of tuberculosis)



The design of the 2½d + 2sh6d (B2) stamp shows an allegory of charity with two female figures dressed in white.

When the rate went to **33¢** in January **1999**
it still sold for 40¢
but had a **33¢** value as postage.

When the First-class Rate changed to 34¢, it still sold for 40¢ per stamp.

In 2007, the First-class Rate was increased to **41¢**, and the price of the Breast Cancer stamp was upped to **55¢**.

Postage value: 34¢

Issued at the same time as the rate-change stamps for the increase to the 37¢ basic First-class rate of 6/30/02, this stamp sold for 45¢ and had a value as postage of 37¢.

It is no longer on sale through the USA Philatelic catalogue, or the USPS web site.

The last time it was listed in the USA Philatelic catalogue was the Fall, 2004 edition, when the First-class Rate was 37¢, so that is its value today.




This semi-postal allowed every American to contribute to a nationwide fight against domestic violence.

Proceeds from the sale of this stamp were used to help agencies across the country to provide:

- shelters for women in need,
- individual and group counseling,
- legal assistance
- court and social service advocacy
- emergency transportation
- urgently needed food and clothing
- prevention programs.

This stamp was withdrawn from sale at the end of 2006, so its value was frozen at the **First-class Rate** in effect on that date, or **39¢**




In 2019, Congress extended the sale of the Breast Cancer Research Stamp to December 31, 2027.

The Alzheimer's Awareness semi-postal stamp, which was issued in 2017, was removed from sale Nov. 30, 2019, the 2-year availability program.

It will now be sold at post offices *once again* beginning Oct. 5.


The U.S. Postal Service also revealed it will no longer impose a two-year sales window for stamps issued in its **discretionary semi-postal program**.
