The Capital City Philatelic Society (CCPS) is a smaller club currently consisting of 28 members with about twelve attending the meetings on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday monthly. As with most clubs in addition to collecting United States stamps many collect countries throughout the world. Several members also have extensive collections of first day covers. So far in 2023 we have added three new members.

When Covid started, club meetings in person and auctions ended. When we started to meet in person AGAIN, the auctions were not initially restarted. The CCPS re-launched stamp

auctions on July 21, 2023. The lots covered two and half tables and included stamps from Russia, Togo, Gibraltar, Ivory Coast, the U.S., plus topicals of Buggs Bunny and Legends of the West, first day covers with cachets by WSE/Clifford and by Harry Igor, an album of gold foil stamps and a framed block of inverted Jennys. Twelve of the lots sold, of which members who brought lots that sold made up to \$21.00 each, and the club got 10% of the \$83.50 total. Feedback was positive regarding our first auction under the new rules. Future auctions are being held on the second Wednesday meeting month, except for the December meeting. Those who would like to enter up to eight lots in the auction should request a form from the club to attach each lot. Each lot may contain as many or few stamps as desired. As each lot is bid on, the form and stamps will go back to the seller if the lot is not sold.

When a lot is sold, the form comes to the Treasurer and the stamps go to the buyer. At the close of the auction, those who have bought stamps will pay the Treasurer and then those who sold stamps will be paid 90% of the winning bid price.

Pink or orange backgrounds showcase pinatas with different 7-pointed stars. These starmps will bring back memories of celebrations with friends and family and inspire new ones.
