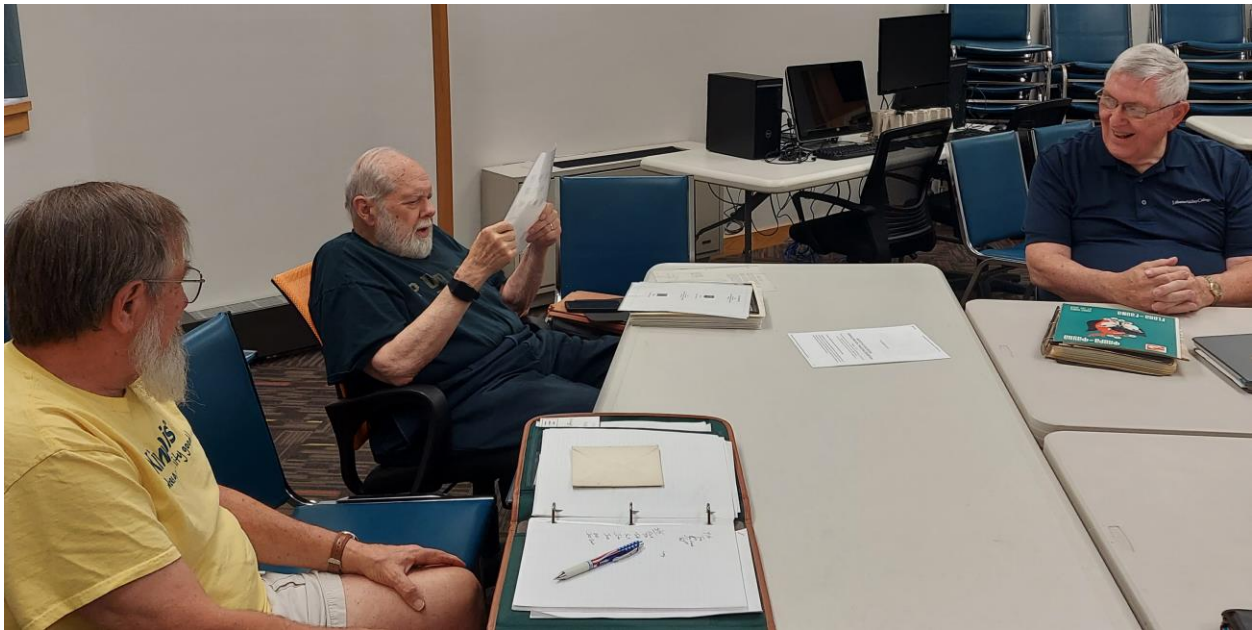

The August meeting of the Lebanon Stamp Collectors Club



Seven members and one visitor enjoyed an evening of Victorian philately at the August meeting of the LSCC.

Before the feature presentation, we got to talking once again about LEBPEX. Tom Shott brought a bag of goodies, and out of the bag came two LEBPEX show programs, from 1975 and 1977, a flyer and exhibition perspectus from 1975, and covers from the 1974 and 1977 shows. The 1975 show flyer notes that the event was sponsored by the “Lebanon Stamp Collectors Club and Lebanon Valley Postal History Society”.

One other club artifact Tom shared was a piece of card stock advertising the following:

Note the different club name (minus “Collectors”) in the meeting notice. This notice surely predates our current meeting location, night of the month, and club name by more than 50 years!

The first LEBPEX catalog and retrospective is scheduled to be issued next month, on what would have been the 50th anniversary of the show.

President Colberg gave us a summary of his experience at the Great American Stamp Show, which he attended this past summer. He also told us about Volunteer Week at the APS, where he is a long-time volunteer in the library.



For the main event, Dick shared his beautiful collection of Queen Victoria issues, which included the above stamp, an 1840 Penny Black with his initials, “R C”. During this pass-around presentation, much of which consisted of his past exhibits on the subject matter, we had an interesting and informative discussion about creating an exhibit, and how exhibiting has changed over the years in the transition from typewriters to computers.
