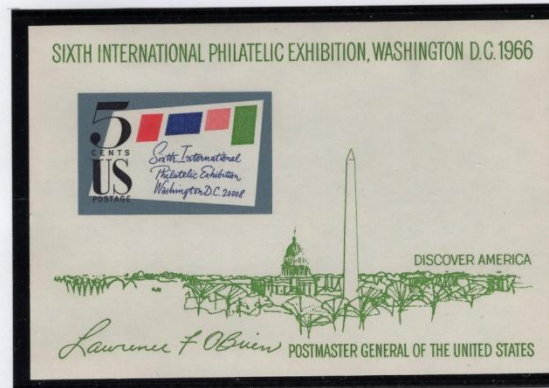


FOLDOVERS

The printing plate had 24 subjects. During production, the marginal inscriptions and plate numbers were cut off and the individual sheets were cut apart for sale. The only way to get a sheet with a plate number is to find one where a foldover occurred prior to cutting. Such foldovers are scarce.

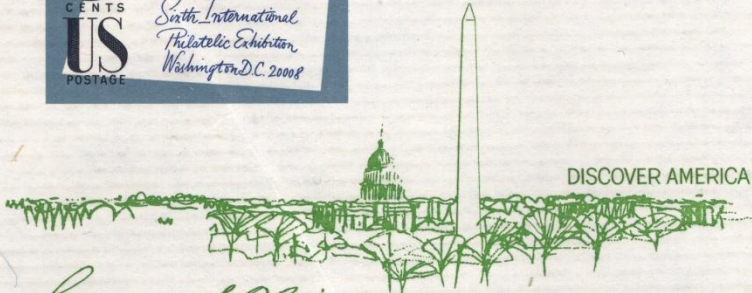

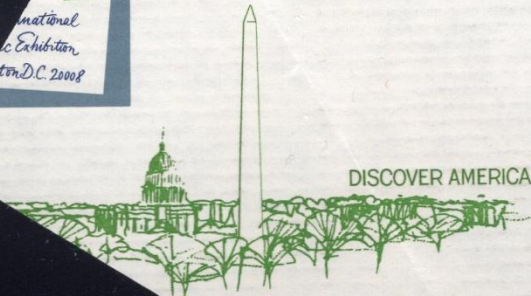

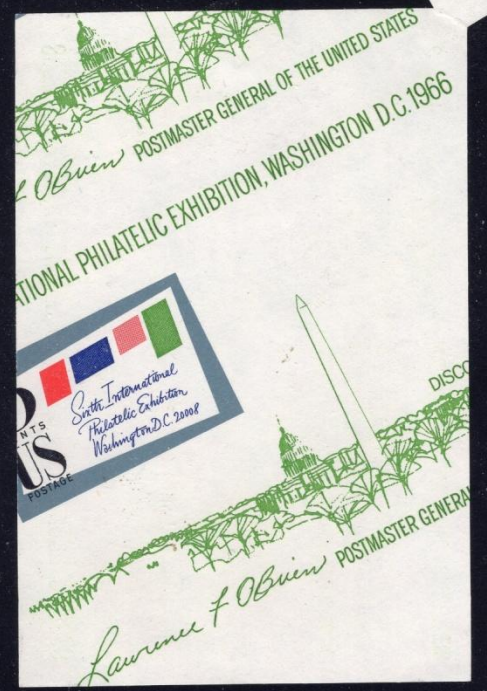
