***The Zeppelin Collector***

The Zeppelin Collectors Club (ZCC) published its newsletter *The Zeppelin Collector* (ZC) in *The Jack Knight Air Log* (JKAL) (also known simultaneously as *AFA News* for many years) quarterly from 1968 to 2012. ZC began as a series of articles in 1968 in the *Pan American Philatelist* of the JKAL and very quickly became its own newsletter. After the AFA/JKAL clubs merged with the American Air Mail Society (AAMS), ZCC became a study unit of the AAMS. *The Zeppelin Collector* (ZC) continued to be published in the quarterly *Jack Knight Air Log* (JKAL), one of the two serial publications of the AAMS, until the board discontinued publication in 2012. The ZCC was affiliate club #135 of the American Philatelic Society (APS).

*The Zeppelin Collector* provided different content than other lighter-than air publications, publishing what was available to buy as well as articles about various collectibles in the zeppelin and airship fields: stamps, mail, medals, postcards, photos, books, etc. Historical articles of interest with illustrations appealed to general as well as specialist zeppelin and airship collectors and enthusiasts.

*The Zeppelin Collector* has had four editors since its inception:

George W. Hoffmann, editor, 1968-1971

Mason Curran, editor, 1972-1976

Cheryl Ganz (nee Johnson), editor, 1976-2002

Cheryl Ganz and Jim Hill, co-editors, 2002 to 2012

For many years ZC had a separate numbering system and an advance bulletin service with its own numbering system. The JKAL began in 1943 with volume 1. In 1978 the ZC numbering of volumes was changed to be identical with the JKAL (Volume 35). Therefore, ZC began in 1968 with the JKAL volume 25.

I am grateful to Terry Sheahan for co-compiling an earlier index and to Richard Van Treuren of Atlantis Productions for publishing that index with other lighter-than-air indexes. This edition combines the earlier index with annually published indexes into one complete index. Further, it uses years rather than volumes (with roman numerals) to make finding articles easier.

As an editor of *ZC* for 36 years, I am grateful to my co-editor Jim Hill and the many researchers, authors, and contributors. A review of content titles indicates how varied the content, so much of which is not represented anywhere else in the literature. It is my sincere hope that the *Zeppelin Collector* informs and inspires future zeppelin collectors, researchers, authors, and philatelists.

## **The ZC Index**

Sample entry: The Voelsch *Hindenburg* Crash Mail (Cheryl Ganz) 2003/1:7.

Format of entry: Article Title (Author) Issue Year/Number (quarterly):Page.

Subject headings include airship names and major flights, people names, place names, and types of collectibles or memorabilia. Airship proper names (or a builder/military identification if that was used as its name) are in italics, for example LZ-129 *Hindenburg*, R100, and USS ZR1 *Shenandoah*. The index reflects the content of feature articles but generally does not include listings (which are rather numerous in the *ZC*) from announcements of new items available to purchase, publications released, book reviews, current blimp news or events, modern pictorial postmarks, and other brief notes of current events. When the entry is from a brief note that does not have a headline title, the first or key words of the entry are quoted.
